



## **School Sanctions**

### **Key Stage 2**

**At St. Joseph's School we expect the highest standard of behaviour to ensure everyone learns well and has a happy time at school. If your behaviour falls below this expectation then the following sanctions will be put in place.**

1. A verbal warning will be given by your teacher.
2. You will be asked to move to another table in the class to show you can focus on your work.
3. You will be asked to complete your work in another class within your Key Stage or a supervised area outside your classroom.
4. If this has happened more than twice your teacher will speak to your parents.
5. If improvement isn't made, Mr. Whitehead, Mr. Modeste and your teacher will meet with you and your parents.
6. If your behaviour still falls below the expectation then a letter will be sent home from the Headteacher, Mr. Williams, and your parents will be invited into school to discuss your next steps.
